Kezia Payne DePelchin — a pioneering teacher, nurse and social worker —accepted three orphaned infants into her care. On May 2, 1892, Kezia was able to move the children into a small, rented house, which she christened "Faith Home".

For more than 130 years, DePelchin has carried out her mission and now has expanded beyond Houston, serving families in New Braunfels, Austin, San Antonio, Lubbock, Greater Houston, Galveston, La Porte, and Richmond. We currently partner with more than 300 families, caring for more than 400 children across Texas.

In the State of Texas, there are more than 15,000 kids in foster care Only 30% of children in foster care will be reunited with their families

Children in the Greatest Need

- Sibling groups of 3 or more 1 in 3 children removed from their families are part of a sibling group
- Teenagers
- Children who are not legally free
- Children who are a member of a minority group that traditionally has barriers to adoption
- Drug-exposed infants and toddlers
- Children with mental health diagnoses and special needs due to trauma
- Children with Primary Medical Needs

Fostering with DePelchin



- Be at least 21 years of age
- Be in good physical health
- Pass a background check
- Be able to provide for a child financially
- Have available bedroom(s)
- Have reliable transportation
- Have a support network
- Be willing to work with birth family
- Be willing to be in the fishbowl
- Have patience and flexibility
- Be willing to put the needs of the children first

Benefits of Working with DePelchin

As a DePelchin foster parent, you have access to:

- ✓ Health & dental coverage for children provided by the state
- ✓ Free breakfast & lunch at school provided by the state
- \checkmark WIC benefits provided by the state for children that qualify
- ✓ 24 hour on call support
- ✓ In-home case management & crisis clinical support
- ✓ Mental health assessment & individualized treatment plan
- ✓ Therapeutic, counseling, & educational services as needed
- ✓ Reimbursement for portion of inspections
- $\checkmark~$ Donation Station support
- ✓ Foster Parent Mentors

Foster Care Adoption with DePelchin

- Families are verified as foster parents and approved as adoptive parents
- DePelchin helps you match with children; CPS makes final selection of families for children
- Children must reside in your home for at least 6 consecutive months prior to finalizing your adoption
- DePelchin will provide attorney referrals and work with DFPS in preparing your court paperwork
- Fees typically range from \$800-\$1,200 and may be reimbursed
- Children may qualify for adoption assistance



Pre-Service Training

- Pre-Service training is a commitment of 40 hours of training, including but not limited to:
 - Creating Caring Connections
 - CPR/First Aid
 - Risk Management & Prevention of Sexual Abuse
 - Agency Related Policies & Procedures
 - Online Trainings
 - Homework



Common Misconceptions

You will not be able to adopt an infant It costs a lot to adopt through foster care You are unable to say No to a placement

FAQs

- Background Checks
 - Applicants
 - Household Members 14 years of age and older
 - Any individual you leave a child alone with in your home or theirs
 - Frequent visitors (visit your home 3 or more times in 30 days)
 - Out of State Background Checks
 - Anyone requiring a background check who lived out of Texas within the last 5 years, we must request from previous state(s) also
- References
 - 1 relative, 1 non-relative, 2 community members
- Pets
- Moving
- Pool
- Alcohol
- Travel
- Weapons & Firearms
- Medication
- Therapy



Next Steps



Attend an orientation meeting (check!)

Submit a complete application

Virtual meeting with DePelchin staff to determine best path forward

Background checks (may take up to 4 weeks)

Complete required pre-service training

Participate in home study, and once complete, have your home study reviewed by committee. If approved, you will become a verified foster care adoption home!



Application Information

- Complete in Binti
- Items to be uploaded to Binti
 - Driver's License for each applicant and others as needed
 - Social security card for each applicant and others as needed
 - Driving record for each applicant
 - Birth certificate or proof of legal residence for each household member
 - Proof of all household income 60 days of paycheck stubs or bank statements
 - Proof of highest education for each applicant
 - Floor plan with labels of all living spaces and dimensions of all areas
 - Final Divorce decree(s), Annulment or judgment of former marriages



- Application, completed and signed
- Priver license, social security card, and birth certificate (or proof of residency) of all applicants.
- Proof of household income: 60 days of pay stubs or bank statements and most recent tax returns
 - Floor plan of home with labels and dimensions
- Contact information for references (they must have an email address)
